Open: 8 rounds, FMJD Swiss system on Solkoff Truncated.

Games rate: **1h' + 30 sec per move.**

Official program: FMJD software Draughts Arbiter will be used.

The tournament will be counted for FMJD world rating with factor 0.5.

7. AWARDS AND PRIZES

The total prize fund is 1 500 EUR.

The participants who will take the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places (U-10, U-13, U-16, U-19 boys and girls) will be awarded with medals, diplomas and valuable awards.
